Fellowship Overview (300 words)	<p>San Diego Sexual Medicine (SDSM) under the leadership of Dr. Irwin Goldstein offers a unique, one-year fellowship in Sexual Medicine and Prosthetic Urology with an option to include Male Infertility under Dr. Martin Bastuba. This fellowship provides the opportunity to learn management of all aspects of sexual dysfunction for both men and women including prosthetic urology, and male infertility for those interested in that field. Surgical procedures are performed at nearby Alvarado Hospital. The fellow is expected to participate in spine-sexual medicine monthly meetings, journal club, sexual medicine rounds and urology and sexual medicine conferences throughout the year including on the Alvarado Hospital campus and the San Diego Urologic Society. The fellow will submit abstracts and attend the annual meetings of the Sexual Medicine Society of North America, the Society of Urologic Prosthetic Surgeons, the International Society for the Study of Women's Sexual Health (ISSWSH), and the American Urological Association, as well as a course in women's sexual health conducted by ISSWSH. The fellow will also be expected to participate in clinical research at SDSM. Upon completion, the fellow will understand the continuum of care approach from clinic to surgery for both men and women with sexual dysfunction, including diagnosis and etiology of the problem as well as treatment and, if desired, male infertility. This includes history taking, physical examination,</p>

	laboratory tests and in office diagnostic procedures including how to perform tests and interpret results. Innovation with Dr. Goldstein is the theme of this unique fellowship with opportunities in developing diagnostic testing, collaborative research with neurophysiology and minimally invasive spine surgery, cutting edge sexual medicine surgery and procedures, first in man clinical trials, and clinical research projects of interest to the fellow.
Research Focus (300 words)	Clinical research involves an opportunity to perform both prospective and retrospective clinical research in such areas as testosterone in women, 5 alpha reductase inhibitor side effects, thermography, and regenerative medicine in several forms. It is expected that research projects will lead to presentations at national and/or international meetings, as well as publications. It is up to the fellow how much time is dedicated to this endeavor.
