<b>Fellowship Overview (300 words)</b>	<p>Tulane University Health Sciences Center has a combined Male Sexual Dysfunction and Reproductive Medicine (Andrology) fellowship. Fellowships are 12-24 months in length and are generally divided between research and clinical services. The research focus utilizes two departmental Ph.D.'s that focuses on various topics of regenerative and reconstructive study. The use of stem cells and animal models has recently focused on Peyronie's disease, post-prostatectomy erectile dysfunction and urethral stricture disease. The clinical fellowship covers the gamut of patient evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment. Fellows participate in three Andrology clinics per week, operate three days per week, and supervise resident surgeries at the affiliated hospitals (University Medical Center &amp; VA). Fellows are expected to be involved in research and publications within the area of Andrology.</p>
