Fellowship Overview (300 words)	The fellowship program at Baylor College of Medicine has been in existence since 1982 and, as of July 2017, over 100 fellows have been trained in the fellowship both here and abroad. All applicants must successfully complete an ACGME-approved Urology residency. Interviews are held in Houston, Texas, over two days. The successful applicants will develop clinical expertise in the diagnosis and treatment of male patients with reproductive failure including infertility, erectile dysfunction, and hypogonadism. A focus on penile prosthetics and the diagnosis and treatment of erectile dysfunction is a strong part of the fellowship. They will gain proficiency in microsurgical techniques required to treat the patient with reproductive dysfunction, including vasal or epididymal obstruction and varicocele repair. Decision making in assisted reproductive techniques as it pertains to sperm acquisition procedures such as micro-epididymal sperm aspiration (MESA) and microscopic testicular sperm extraction (TESE) will be developed. Fellows will attend all outpatient clinics with Dr. Lipshultz and participate in both operating room and clinical procedures.
