Fellowship Overview (300 words)	<p>This fellowship provides broad exposure to male sexual and reproductive issues, including testosterone deficiency and treatment, erectile dysfunction, Peyronie's disease, male infertility, various sperm harvesting procedures, BPH. Fellows will train with Dr. Morgentaler, and Dr. William Connors. Clinical research projects are required, including prospective and retrospective chart reviews. There is no basic science component. Fellows operate at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, and at an outpatient surgicenter. Fellows participate in hospital urology conferences and Journal club. By end of year fellows will have outstanding background in all aspects of men's health/andrology.</p>
Research Focus (300 words)	<p>Research projects at this time focus largely on testosterone deficiency and its treatment. In the past a major focus has been the relationship of testosterone and prostate cancer. Current interests have broadened to include metabolic aspects of T deficiency and treatment. There are ongoing projects in Peyronie's disease.</p>
