Fellowship Overview (300 words)	<p>The UCLA Urologic Sexual Dysfunction and Infertility fellowship provides a post-residency training program in the clinical and surgical aspects of both disciplines. To meet these objectives, the training program takes full advantage of the constellation of organized academic resources at UCLA. This includes participation in the diagnosis and treatment of patients with sexual dysfunction and infertility at three of our institutions: the Westside VA hospital, the Ronald Reagan Medical Center (RRHMC) and the Harbor-UCLA Medical Center. These institutions provides the fellow with exposure to not only a diversity of populations but also to a number of outstanding faculty members with various interests within these two disciplines. The fellow will also have an opportunity to participate in clinical research where ongoing research is practiced by most of the faculty.</p>
